

Dear Staff, Parents and Pupils,

The Government has announced today, that from tomorrow, Thursday 20th January, there is no longer a requirement to wear face coverings within the classroom setting (currently year 7 to U6). Pupils and staff may continue to wear face-coverings in the classroom should they wish to and there presently remains an expectation to wear face coverings on school transport and in indoor communal areas. We will also continue to ask visitors to our school to adhere to our communal area guidance, unless exempt from doing so. We are expecting a full update from the Department of Education (DfE) shortly and will advise any additional changes effective from 27th January, in due course.
