



Purpose and job specification

- To check and prepare materials, resources, and equipment for lessons including the preparation of ingredients for practical sessions.
 - To undertake the cleaning of equipment and materials and ensure that all items are stored and labelled to a level acceptable under the Food Safety Act, in particular student dishes.
 - To support with the preparation of learning resources and to undertake administrative tasks under the direction of the Head of Food and Nutrition.
 - Set-up necessary equipment and ingredients required by teachers
 - Work alongside teachers during theory and practical lessons to aid student progress, providing technical advice, as required.
 - Undertake inventory checks and order materials
 - Maintain food store cupboard and be responsible for stock rotation.
 - Be fully aware of all food allergies and dietary needs of students taking part in Food and Nutrition lessons.
 - Organise and maintain the
- appropriate learning environment, take responsibility for aspects of class organisation and display. Prepare and maintain a range of resources and specialist equipment when required.
- To lead and organise the ordering of ingredientsl deliveries, appropriate storage and provide copies of orders to account
