Nelson Scholars

Awarded annually to two outstanding young people, the Nelson Scholarship offers a fully-funded two-year place in the Sixth Form at Langley School alongside mentoring and leadership support.

Nelson Fellows

Nelson Fellows, also awarded annually to two young people, will receive a partially-funded two-year fellowship into the Sixth Form at Langley School with a 50% reduction in fees, alongside mentoring and leadership support. A means tested bursary can be applied for in addition to the Fellowship.
